5A Improvements in Sunnyside

Calgary's pathways and bikeways offer an extensive network that many Hillhurst Sunnyside residents enjoy. However, the City's 2020 Transportation Plan describes the current network as one that only serves "recreational users as well as confident and dedicated cyclists".

To address this concern the City created the 5A Network plan, where the five A's stand for: Always Available for All Ages and Abilities. The purpose of the 5A plan is to evolve Calgary's pathways and bikeways to be more inclusive, have broader use and fewer barriers. In other words, make it so anyone no matter their ability, can feel comfortable choosing to ride a bike, scooter, trike, or e-bike as a form of transportation any day of the year.

The good news for Hillhurst Sunnyside is it will see 5A Network improvements in the community in 2024!

Thanks to the City of Calgary's Riley Area Improvements initiative (previously called Kensington Area Projects) the City will be bringing investment to the 2 Ave NW and 7 Ave NW corridor. The result will be bikeway, walkway, and transit upgrades on this corridor that will be more welcoming to children, seniors, and people with mobility challenges.

This corridor is particularly important because it provides connections to important destinations within our neighbourhood such as the Sunnyside School, the Sunnyside LRT station, businesses in Kensington and residences throughout the neighbourhood.

Implementing this initiative will mean the street will change. Excessively wide vehicle lanes will be narrowed

so their design-speed matches our residential speed limit. Currently the lanes are wider than lanes on Deerfoot, no wonder people drive too fast. In the space that is created from narrowing the vehicle lanes, protected mobility lanes will be built.


If you park your vehicle on this corridor today, the exact spot you park might change. When these changes come, please keep in mind the safe and inclusive opportunity it will create for all people who live in our neighbourhood today as well as tomorrow. People like the kid next door who is one of the 170 elementary school children who attend Sunnyside School. Or people like the grandparents across the street who've been hesitant to ride their bike or trike to the grocery store because they don't feel safe riding on streets with big pickup trucks and SUVs.

Providing the freedom for all ages and abilities to be actively mobile anytime in a safe environment will be a great exercise in removing societal barriers. It will also promote physical activity, build vibrancy in our community, and most importantly demonstrate that we value the safety of people who choose active mobility.


