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

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
Help Us Find a Cover Photo!

As of the beginning of March, we've successfully fulfilled 29 hamper requests this calendar year, providing essential support to 17 individuals and families within our community. Your ongoing support and contributions are invaluable, serving as the backbone of this sustained initiative that extends a helping hand to our neighbours.

Items in Low Supply: If you're looking to contribute to a cause that directly benefits your community, consider donating items in current demand, such as cereal, nut butters, canned vegetables, and canned fruits. Drop-off donations are accepted at the Ranchlands Community Association RFP box, conveniently located in the foyer at 7713 Ranchview Drive NW. Operating hours are Monday to Friday from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm, with extended hours until 6:00 pm on Mondays. Additionally, we are in need of toothbrushes and toothpaste. Your support is deeply appreciated!

Volunteer Opportunities: Join us in making a difference! We're actively searching for an individual to assist in packing food hampers from 1:30 to 3:30 pm every second and third Monday of the month. Moreover, we're excited to announce a pilot expansion of our program in collaboration with Second Harvest Food Rescue. We're in need of three volunteers to monitor the food rescue app, identifying donations that align with our pantry needs. These volunteers should have a flexible schedule to pick up donations from various locations across the city and deliver them to the Ranchlands Community Association from Monday to Friday. While there are no set hours for this role, we anticipate it will require no more than three hours a week of a volunteer's time.

Spill the Local Beans: I was born in Coleraine in Northern Ireland, near Giant's Causeway and Bushmills Distillery.

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
