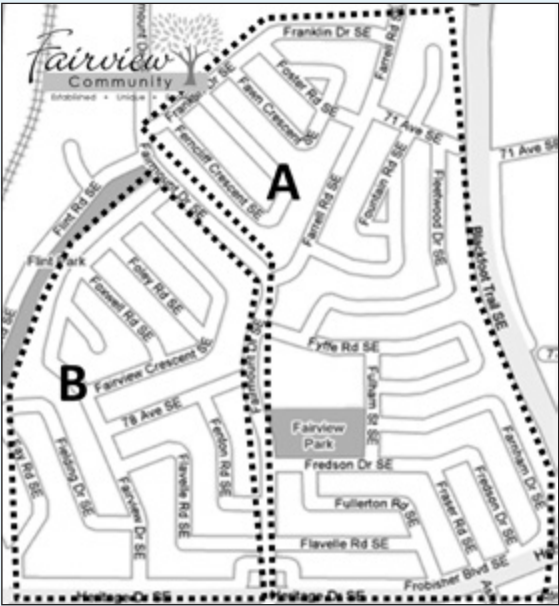

Get Involved: Fairview Park Committee

Fairview Park is the area south of the two schools including the former arena site, along Fredson Drive. Most recently, the FCA worked to activate the "Sparkling Lot" on the lower paved part of this space, but it has a long history! You can read about its use since the community was started in the 1960s on the FCA website under Your Community > History (fairviewcommunity.ca/your-community/history).

Rejuvenation Planning

The Fairview Park site is undergoing a period of change in light of the arena's collapse and removal. The former community hall, owned by the City and currently occupied by the NaAC (formerly Indefinite Arts), is slated for demolition by the City after NaAC relocates.

The Fairview Park Committee is looking at possible opportunities for the future of the space. This community-driven park development project will take some time to bring to fruition, so it makes sense to get started sooner rather than later. We would need to be prepared for decisions stemming from the upcoming demolition work, like whether we would like the City to leave anything behind (e.g. should the expensive pavement/parking area be torn up, etc.).

What We Need from You

We need active community engagement and involvement in planning for the future of the space. Currently, we are looking for community residents to become committee members to help build a full engagement plan and park design. We will canvas the broader community for ideas later this spring and summer.

If you have a couple hours per month to spare, we would love you to join the Fairview Park Committee.
