Spring Cleaning Your Finances

3. See Where You Can Start Saving



Indicate in green the money that comes in your account monthly and indicate in red the money that comes out. You can create an easy equation after doing this to see how much money you have left every month.



When all this is done you could possibly see that you no longer use a certain subscription and could save money by unsubscribing, or you have a bank account you no longer use which you can close.

All of this may seem like a bit of a hassle, but once it is done you will not regret spring cleaning your finances. It will only make your life easier moving forward.

On April 22, City Council will undergo a public hearing and decide on whether or not to make some major changes to what type of building is allowed on properties in Calgary. I voted against moving forward with this, but here we are.

As a part of this public hearing, I must remain open to persuasion. That is the law, but it is also important to me to be open to what Calgarians think. There have been some opportunities for input, but it has not been enough.

Dear constituents.

As I write this, the Auditor General's report on the ArriveCAN app has been resting with the Canadian public for a little over two weeks. Her report outlined the ArriveCAN application – which previous analysis has shown could've been made for as little as \$80,000 has ballooned to a jaw-dropping cost of at least \$60 million dollars! That's 750 times over budget! In her report the Auditor General wrote, "overall the CBSA, Public Health Agency of Canada, and Public Services and Procurement Canada repeatedly failed to follow good management practices in the contracting, development, and implementation of the ArriveCAN application."

GC Strategies a four-person company run out of a basement, received \$19.5 million dollars on ArriveCAN contracts despite doing no actual work on the app! We've also learned that GC Strategies has been the recipient of over a quarter of a billion dollars in other government contracts since Justin Trudeau took office in 2015.

As the Official Opposition Shadow Minister for Treasury Board, I have been digging for answers on ArriveCAN since the fall of 2022 – and I won't be stopping until Canadian taxpayers get the answers they deserve.


